As a non-profit organization, all monies collected go for supplies/events to educate the public about 811! There was discussion regarding what money from the OUCC can be used for. Damage Report:

Be sure to report your damages each month!

All damage reports need to be made using the Damage Information Reporting Tool (DIRT) from the Common Ground Alliance (CGA). You can check this out at www.cga-dirt.com. There is a link to (DIRT) on the OUCC website. Pease sign up and start reporting. Additional information on how to use DIRT and share your general reporting info will be coming soon from the OUCC.

There are questions from smaller operators about how the information will be used. These concerns are coming up because the State is looking at making reporting mandatory. The information is intended to help identify areas that are having difficulties. It does seem that the larger Utilities are reporting.

NOTE: Only facility owners should submit reports on their facilities. This will prevent double reporting should excavators report on a damage they did to a facility owner. It only takes minutes each month!!

Tony from Potelco came and talked about the locate problems they are having. They are trying to determine who to contact. Andy Mulick from PGE will be available if he can help with locates. There was some talk about staggering tickets instead of calling in 20 in a day. This will give the locator more time to complete. Bryan Baxter talked about meet tickets. This may help the locator know what area to concentrate on first based on where the contractor is planning to be. Scott pointed out that OR law gives the locator 48 hours to complete the ticket. Jarrod Morrison said that Verizon had weekly meetings and asked if PGE should have this type of meeting. Bryan commented that weekly meetings are a good way to try to resolve issues quickly. Potelco agreed to host meetings and Bryan suggested Thursdays.
