7. State Business:

- a. OUCC is working on getting the DIRT (Damage) Reports out to the councils.
- b. OAR Committee changes to Dig Laws:
 - i. Change "48 hour" to full "2 business days" This was voted in.
 - ii. "mutually agreed upon" start time added to rules if it is within 10 days, to allow more than 2 days for locates if the work is actually starting after the 2 day window
 - iii. 45 day ticket life
 - iv. Positive Response: voluntary at first. The brochure has been put together, and is going through approvals. Upon approval, the start date will be stated.
 - v. Vertical tolerance of 2' under discussion
 - vi. FMSA code operators to call 911 when there is a release of gas
 - vii. Through RAA
 - 1. Late response to tickets \$1000 on first day
 - 2. \$5000 on second day, and each day after
 - viii. Manual revision date will be on the inside of the cover
 - ix. Mandatory reporting is under discussion
 - x. Positively identify utilities crossed by excavating to the utilities or to 2 feet below your pipe zone
