- b. The OUCC is working on coordinating the reports from DIRT to share with all UCC's.
- c. <u>Near Misses:</u> Metro UCC would like to hear about all "near misses" that occur, to help others know what is happening around our area, and how we can make changes to avoid the near misses.

- i. Washington County Frontier 2 marks on ground but there were 3 cables, 2 were abandoned, 1 was not marked, they hit the one that was active.
- ii. Safety note Springville Rd / 185th a drunk driver went past multiple work zone signs, then took out a pole just before the work zone.
- iii. PGE many of the damage reports coming in are reports on not calling for locates, and the majority of those not calling are companies (not home owners).
- iv. Precision Locates property owners are getting misinformation from someone about locates on private property. Possibly from other locate companies.
- v. PGE is having discussions with their crews on what to do when a line is hit.
- vi. Washington County a line was hit at the Public Service Building there were no locates.
