o Projects:

- ODOT: Fixing approximately 30,000 ADA ramps in the next 20 years due to lawsuit. They are developing a committee to avoid utilities or relocate them in some cases. Starting in Estacada, Molalla and Sandy to start in 2020. They will be busy in 2020 busier in 2021. City Fiber projects in Sherwood and Hillsboro. Sherwood to start in 2020 and Hillsboro is ongoing. PGE is anticipating 165,000 feet of cable replacement in 2020 with a great deal of it in Gresham.
- o Old Business: None to report.
- o New Business:
 - o Inquiry regarding safe excavation video and dig ins. PGE would like to see this as a method to help train excavators. Possibly requiring the video with the course certificate in addition to the insurance required by contractors to have a permit in PGE ROW and for subcontractors doing PGE work in ROW. This could be utilized in situations with claims and problematic excavators. There is a 25% discount for businesses and excavators who are taking the safe excavation class for the first time. Homeowners can take the course online. Internally it may be a great idea as well. The course takes approximately an hour and is available through the OUNC website. Mike Hieb.
