DISCUSSION	Work Around The Area
<p>City of Ontario: The signal light at Northwest Washington has been installed and is scheduled to be operating by the middle of the month. There is also a plan currently in review for the City's public works as well as water and sewer services to be taken over by CH2MHill.</p> <p>ODOT: A project is underway in Nyssa to replace sidewalks on the East side of the train tracks as well as both sides of Thunderegg from the signal light to Locust. The final stage of the project will be a grind / inlay of asphalt on Thunderegg (US20/26.)</p> <p>Cascade Natural Gas: A leaking gas line in Ontario was reported in the front yard of a residence in town. It turned out to be a homeowner installing a sprinkler system had hit the</p>	

pipe while trenching then covered it up and later determined it was leaking. No locates were requested for the work.

CenturyLink: A communications pedestal had been hit in front of the Council on Aging in Ontario. Brad was going to take a look at it while in the area.
