ATKORE Rocky Mtn Colby (Pendleton) – 3000A ug service – conduit/vault work done – no update
Steeples house (Birch Creek Rd, Pendleton) – 700' ug extension – no update
Wells house (Birch Creek, Pendleton) – no update
Umatilla County is still trying to get around their franchise agreement and force relocation of poles at
no cost to County – north side of Stanfield.
