- W 2nd St. project out to bid opening bids for September 7 have been delayed to October 5 due to Hurricane Harvey and the lack of PVC pipe available. May need to extend bids out further, dependent upon PVC availability.
- Sanitary sewer from 8th street delayed due to lack of PVC pipe
- Reservoir painting project continues and has been delayed due to wildfires/ash in area
- Chip sealing completed on E 10th, Dry Hollow, Thompson, Port Area and 4th Street Downtown
- Crack sealing until weather prevents work
- Striping and signage Downtown area is focus area
