Manhole Rehabilitation Project – Integrity Inspection Solutions – to start Monday (4.24.23)

New Bus Barn (NW 48th & H Ave) – McCormack Const – waiting for site plan – on hold

BMCC Farm II Project (SW 18th Street) – zone change approved

McCormack Construction new office building and shop (1761 SW 32nd PI) – ongoing

New car wash (217 SW 23rd St, behind Safeway) – bldg permit issued – construction has not started

Coyote Business Park (Pendleton) – new Verizon cell tower – ug lines – no update
Well 11B Pump House (Pendleton WWTP, Houtama Road) – waiting on Tim Smith for upgrade info
NE King (Pendleton) – Marshall's 4 lots – sent new contract
Bus Barn (City of Pendleton) – negotiating location; plans redesigned and returned – on hold
Buena Vista Subdivision (Canal Road, Stanfield) – Phase I – 29 lots; 200 total lots – SGS Development
Threemile Canyon Farms (Boardman) – 4 new services and ug lines for cattle stock yards - summer
Aspen Heights Subdivision (Athena) – 24 total lots; Phase I – 9 lots; Phase II – 9 lots - redesigning
McCormack Construction (Pendleton) – office building and shop – primary conduit in - ongoing
Hay Creek Solar Project (Weston) – complex line installation – 3 - 4 poles – had to be restaked
South Hill Commons (Franklin Grade Road) – 70 apts, 4 bldgs – 3 new street lights and poles; 1 existing
pole needs relocated – waiting on conduit installation
Sage Hill Subdivision (Barfuss; Pendleton) – 30+ lots – waiting on final design – no update
Wildhorse Resort and Casino (Pendleton) – 10,000 sf office and storage bldg – conduit work complete,
no wires yet – to start soon
Athena (behind PGG building) – 100' oh to ug conversion – no update
New Airport Reservoir and Booster Pump Station (Old Airport Road, Pendleton) – waiting on City to
provide power
Westgate Apts (Pendleton) – waiting on conduit uphill; half has been installed - relocated two poles
Umatilla County is still trying to get around their franchise agreement and force relocation of poles at
no post to County, north side of Stanfield

City of Hermiston:

Water line replacement – N 1st Place from W Hermiston Ave to W Elm Avenue – replacing 2" line with 12" line

Cascade Natural Gas:

View Wood Estates, Phase 2 (Hermiston) – 23 lots – schedule is pending

City of Hermiston Well #6 (behind Ranch and Home) – main extension and service line

SE 3rd Street (Pendleton) – to verify locations and depths prior to construction this year

Bore across Umatilla River/Westgate Drive Pedestrian Bridge (Pendleton) – in the near future

Williams NW Pipeline:

Powerline Road Project (Umatilla) – east side of road; water main has to go under their line – Apollo is contractor – monitoring construction at the site

Oregon Dept. of Transportation:

ADA curb ramps project (Milton-Freewater) – going north

Chip sealing (Hwy 730, Umatilla) – from Sand Station towards Washington State line – May

Hwy 730 (East of Hat Rock) – 24 hr road closure May 2nd and 3rd to replace collapsed 54" casing

I-84 (Exit 216) - turnaround road in chain up area for unchained trucks to turn around – in design

Hwy 320 Bridge (Echo) – monitoring due to erosion caused by flooding

New West Park Elementary School Project (Hermiston) – Hwy 207 from Orchard Ave to Highland Ave installing new curbs, gutters, sidewalks on west side only and a rapid flashing beacon/crosswalk I-84 (Cabbage Hill) – shoulder erosion repair project
